

WAM at Home - Lesson 6C

What you will need:

- Device to play song (if you're not singing it on your own)
- Bible
- Sticks or wooden spoons or blocks that you could tap together
- Keyboard/Piano

This week's verse: Luke 1:37

"For the word of God will never fail."

Step 1 (5-10 minutes)

- Color the coloring page and/or answer the questions on the verse doodle page (older children may want to do the verse doodle page instead of the coloring page, but they're free to do either or both!)

Step 2 (5-10 minutes)

- Read Luke 1:37 from this paper or from your Bible. Encourage older children to find Luke and read along with you.
- Discuss the questions from the verse doodle page. Older children can share the answers they came up with or you may all discuss them together. Older children can also share their drawings and describe what they drew.

This week's questions:

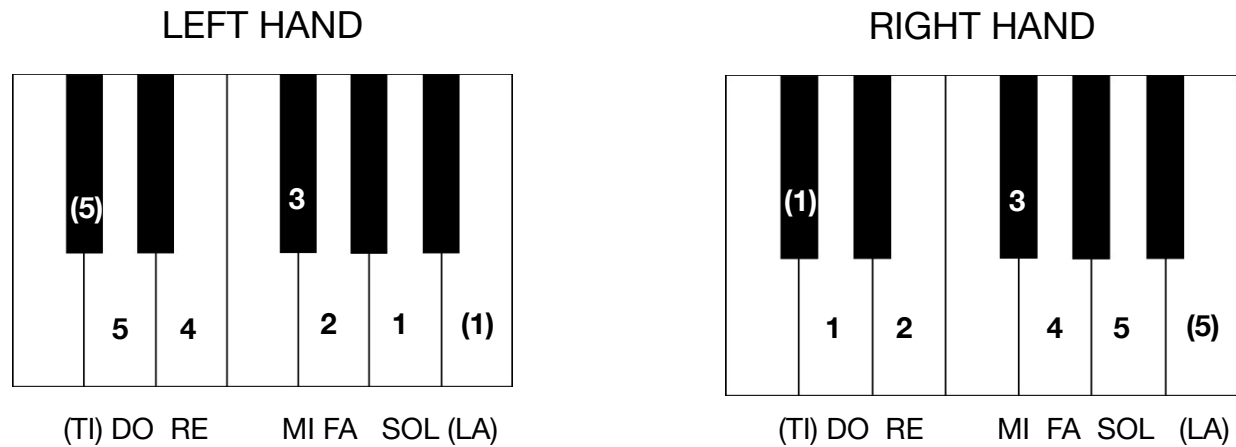
1. Have you ever studied for a test so much that you knew you would do well and weren't nervous about it at all?
2. When you work hard and prepare for something, does it make you feel at peace about it or anxious?
3. In this passage, the angel Gabriel is speaking to Mary and telling her about Elizabeth becoming the mother of John the Baptist. When God says He's going to do something, He's going to do it. Period. We won't know exactly when or how or why He'll do it but we can be absolutely 100% certain that things will happen the way that He has said it will. If God makes a promise, He will keep that promise no matter what. Take a moment now to pray and thank God for always keeping His promises and ask Him to help you always trust in those promises and God's trustworthiness.

DRAW: Something peaceful

Step 3 (10-15 minutes)

- Sing through "Books of the New Testament" or listen to the recording as many times as you'd like. Once you're familiar with the song, try singing it yourself!
- Now find your D position. Remember, the "D" is the white key between the group of two black keys:
- Once you've found your D position in each hand, play and sing Do-Mi-Sol-Mi with each hand, like this:
 - LH: fingers 5 - 3 - 1 - 3
 - RH: fingers 1 - 3 - 5 - 3
- Then play and sing Fa-Re-Ti-Sol using both hands, like this:
 - RH: fingers 4 - 2 - 1* LH: finger 1

- You'll need to move your RH finger 1 (thumb) to the first white key in the group of two so it's playing "Ti" instead of "Do"



- Now you can use these two patterns to play the melody as you sing the song, like this (RH fingers numbers in Red, LH finger numbers in Blue)
