

#### **SUNDAY SCHOOL:**

**HCC Kids Sunday School** (age 4 - 5<sup>th</sup> grade): Join us after worship in the education wing. Each class takes a Christ-centered, chronological look at the big story of the Bible; God's plan to rescue His people through His son, Jesus.

**The Bridge Sunday School**: All 6th-12th grade students are invited to this time of community, fellowship, and learning after worship. Students are walking through *The New City Catechism*, discussing questions and answers that help summarize our theology and put it into our own words; led by our Youth & Young Adult Ministry Director, Christian Brandon. Pastor Jonathan will also be holding Confirmation Class for the 9<sup>th</sup> graders.

#### Adult Sunday School (2 options):

Dan Sullivan continues his class in Patterson Hall, *Knowing God* based on J.I.
