

WAM at Home - Lesson 19C

What you will need:

- Device to play song (if you're not singing it on your own)
- Bible
- Keyboard/Piano

This week's verse: Luke 6:46-49

"So why do you keep calling me 'Lord, Lord!' when you don't do what I say? I will show you what it's like when someone comes to me, listens to my teaching, and then follows it. It is like a person building a house who digs deep and lays the foundation on solid rock. When the floodwaters rise and break against that house, it stands firm because it is well built. But anyone who hears and doesn't obey is like a person who builds a house right on the ground, without a foundation. When the floods sweep down against that house, it will collapse into a heap of ruins."

Step 1 (5-10 minutes)

- Color the coloring page and/or answer the questions on the verse doodle page (older children may want to do the verse doodle page instead of the coloring page, but they're free to do either or both!)

Step 2 (5-10 minutes)

- Read Luke 6:46-49 from this paper or from your Bible. Encourage older children to find Luke and read along with you.
- Discuss the questions from the verse doodle page. Older children can share the answers they came up with or you may all discuss them together. Older children can also share their drawings and describe what they drew.

This week's questions:

1. What would happen if you apologized after doing something wrong but then did that wrong thing again right away?
2. Would your apology mean anything if you said you were sorry but didn't actually change your behavior?
3. Jesus wants us to not only listen to what He is saying but to make our actions match those lessons. If we just read the Bible but don't put any of those words into practice, it's not actually living into what Jesus was telling His followers—including us! Take a moment to thank Jesus for His lessons and ask for His help in putting them into practice every day.


DRAW: The house on the rock

Step 3 (10-15 minutes)

- Sing through "The Wise Man and the Foolish Man" or listen to the recording as many times as you'd like. Once you're familiar with the song, try singing it yourself!
- Now find your F position with your right hand thumb on middle F and your left hand pinky on the F just below the middle F on the piano:

LEFT HAND

RIGHT HAND

- Once you've found your F position in each hand, find your mini I and mini V7 chords

LEFT HAND:

Mini I chord - finger 5 (Do) and finger 1 (Sol) together: "Do—Sol—Do, mini I chord"

Mini V7 chord - finger 1 (Sol) and finger 2 (Fa) together: "Sol—Fa—Sol, mini V7 chord"


RIGHT HAND:

Mini I chord - finger 1 (Do) and finger 5 (Sol) together: "Do—Sol—Do, mini I chord"

Mini V7 chord - finger 5 (Sol) and finger 4 (Fa) together: "Sol—Fa—Sol, mini V7 chord"

- Now play a steady beat on your I chord with both hands at the same time
- Play a steady beat on your V7 chord with both hands at the same time
- Now put them together and play four I chords, then four V7 chords and repeat that pattern a few times
- Once you have that pattern down, you can put it together with the song, like this:

- When you shout “SMASH!”, play all five fingers of each hand all together at the same time to make a big, splatty, crash of notes!
