1. Is it ever strange to think of your parents as little kids? What about your grandparents? Can you even imagine them being a kid like you? Ask to see a picture of the when they were little if you’re really curious!
2. No matter how old we get, we are always someone’s child, and most importantly, we are always God’s child. What do you think about that?
3. John is reminding us of two things in this verse: God loves us as His children, and we are God’s children because we believe Jesus is God’s Son and He died on the cross and rose to life again. If you’ve been unsure about if Jesus was who He said He was, talk to your parents or one of your Sunday School teachers about it and ask lots of questions. Questions are great (just look at how Jesus answered people when they asked Him questions)! If you do believe Jesus was who He said He was, take a moment to pray and tell Him that you believe and that you want Him to be the Lord of your life. If you do pray that, share that news with your parents and the other grownups in your life!
